

GTEC moves to a new headquarters in Berlin-Mitte to open up to more universities

- **The German Tech Entrepreneurship Center (GTEC) is moving to new headquarters even closer to the Berlin founder and entrepreneur scene**
- **Almost two years after being founded, GTEC is expanding its programmes to more universities**

Berlin, 11. April 2017 – The [German Tech Entrepreneurship Center \(GTEC\)](#), Europe's first private-sector open campus for technology, innovation and entrepreneurship, is growing and will move its headquarters in a new location in Berlin-Mitte on June 1st, 2017. To be even closer to the ecosystem of founders in Germany's capital, GTEC will move into [Mindspace](#), one of Berlin's premier startup coworking spaces and hailing from Israel. Numerous founders and startups that GTEC has already had the honor to work with are based there. The move will also further strengthen the ties between Berlin and Israel that have been established by several projects with [IDC Herzliya](#), [starTAU](#) and [exist](#). Moreover, Mindspace is home to many corporate teams like Daimler and Samsung, allowing GTEC to drive technology, innovation and entrepreneurship more intensively at an independent location.

Alongside startups and corporates, GTEC's third pillar is academia. Since its foundation on the campus of a private university almost two years ago, GTEC has enriched the existing programmes for its MBA and Masters students. These programmes will be integrated into the offerings of leading tech and business schools, so GTEC will still be the unique combination of startups, corporates und academia.

In the past two years, GTEC has played a vital role to propel digital transformation, innovation and entrepreneurship in Germany and beyond. To accomplish that, GTEC worked with over thirty corporations and institutions like Innogy, the European Union, Hasso-Plattner Institut, Zeppelin Universität, the BMW Foundation, Bosch and Union Investment. More than 4.000 international people who are interested in entrepreneurship and innovation took part in GTEC's events. For example, the *Open Lectures* took place over 50 times and have had over 1.500 guests to date. Over 20 executive education programmes incorporating colloquiums and workshops for Dax companies and for SMEs have also added to the digitisation efforts.

With the new locations, GTEC will further expand these activities.
